What will the course cover?

The PMI-RMP® exam is a foray into the unknown for many PMP®s. It's a divergence from the *Guide to the Project Management Body of Knowledge* with the additional areas of the Risk Management standard produced by PMI and with the host of other outside source materials so common to PMI® exams, but so unfamiliar to those who deal with risks on a day-to-day, rather than academic, basis.

Objectives
